Dear Culpepper Garden I Resident,


During the Resident meetings on January 18, 2017 and July 14, 2017, Judith Cabelli with Wesley Housing Development Corporation, announced the availability of 21 accessible apartments that will be created during the renovation. Judith provided a description of the features of an accessible apartment as well as the universal design features that will be incorporated into all renovated apartments.

To determine who will move into the accessible apartments, you were asked to indicate your interest during your individual meeting with the Relocation Coordinator. If you indicated your interest at that time, we have your information and we will contact you to complete the necessary paperwork to determine if you qualify for an accessible apartment.

We are providing an additional opportunity for you to indicate your interest in an accessible apartment to make sure that every resident who needs an accessible apartment has been identified. If you have not already done so, please indicate your interest in an accessible apartment by completing the information below and returning it to Hunter Moore at the Administrative Office of Culpepper Garden by July 24, 2017.

Culpepper Garden will begin the process of determining eligibility for an accessible apartment during the week of July 24, 2017 and will aim to get back to residents in September. Apartments will be assigned based on a priority ranking system with a goal to provide qualified residents an opportunity to move into an accessible apartment in closest proximity to his/her current apartment. Culpepper Garden reserves the right to reassign apartments based on resident need, up until the time of the move into an accessible apartment.
